He also has served as a consultant to developers, non-profit organizations and government agencies on how best to use programs such as the LIHTC program. Moss serves on the boards for the New York State Association for Affordable Housing, the National Leased Housing Association, the Florida Coalition of Affordable Housing Providers, the National Housing & Rehabilitation Association, the Illinois Housing Council and the Michigan Housing Council (as advisor). He also serves on the advisory boards for more than 20 state agencies responsible for allocating housing tax credits.
